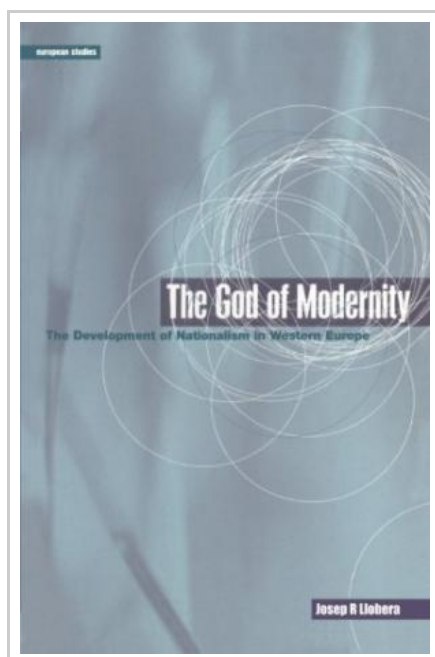




The God of Modernity: The Development of Nationalism in Western Europe
