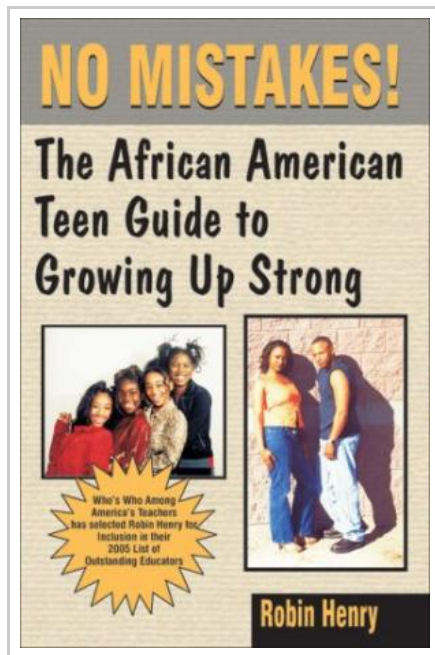




No Mistakes:: The African American Teen Guide to Growing Up Strong
