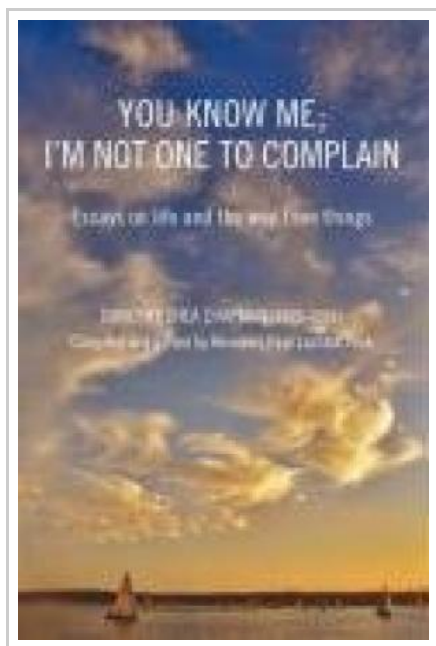




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You Know Me; I m Not One to Complain: Essays on Life and the Way I See Things
